

Safety information for not dangerous material

Pigment powder: neon

For coloring of ivory resin.

Colours: neon yellow, neon orange, neon pink

This product is not classified according to (EC) Regulation No 1272/2008.

According to our current knowledge the product does not contain hazardous ingredients.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

Slightly aldehyde odour, water-insoluble fine powders

pH: 6,5-8,5.

Relative density 1,3 g/cm³

Melting point/freezing point : 270-280 °C

Health hazards

Eye contact may irritate or scratch the surface of the eye. Moderate skin contact should not irritate but excessive or prolonged contact or rubbing may cause mechanical irritation. Excessive inhalation of dust may irritate the respiratory tract.

Under some conditions of use and storage, air concentrations of formaldehyde reaching or exceeding 0.1 ppm may occur. Formaldehyde is a potential cancer hazard, highly irritating to the eyes, nasal passages, and throat, and may cause sensitization of the respiratory system.

MEDICAL CONDITIONS GENERALLY AGGRAVATED BY EXPOSURE: By exposure to formaldehyde, chronic diseases of the respiratory system, skin, and eyes.

Environmental exposure/Ecological Information

According to our current knowledge adverse ecological effects are not expected. The products are not water soluble and not volatile, and therefore considerable mobility is not expected.

Do not allow into surface water or drains.

Fire-Fighting Measures

The product is . nonflammable, but will burn if involved in a fire. May form an explosive dust cloud if the finely divided particles are suspended in air. Avoid dust generation.

Precautions for safe handling

Avoid dust generation. Handle in accordance with good industrial hygiene and safety practice.

Keep container closed when not in use to protect product quality.

After use thoroughly wash hands or take a shower. Workers should wash hands and face before eating, drinking and smoking.

Storage, storage stability, transport Information

Store in a dry area away from flames, sparks, static build up, and excessive heat.

Transport Information (ADR/RID, ADN, IMDG, ICAO/IATA)

Not classified as a dangerous good under transport regulations. Storage duration: In original, closed container is unlimited if stored and handled as prescribed/indicated.

First-Aid Measures

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical attention if symptoms occur. Wash skin with soap and water.
